

Move heralds expansion for Yorkshire pudding producer

A YORKSHIRE pudding producer is planning to expand following the purchase of a new food production facility.

The Real Yorkshire Pudding Co, based in Thorne near Doncaster, produces chilled and frozen Yorkshire puddings for retailers, the food service industry and ready meal manufacturers.

The company has signed a deal to acquire a vacant property adjacent to its existing facility at Coulman Road.

In a freehold deal brokered by Leeds-based industrial property specialist [Gent Visick](#), The Real Yorkshire Pudding Co has bought the 26,260 sq ft unit, previously used by Conquest Foods for potato processing, from owners Threadneedle Property Investments for an undisclosed sum.

Nathan Hargreaves, of Threadneedle Property Investments, said: “This is an ideal outcome. We’re delighted to have reached an agreement with the Real Yorkshire Pudding Co to purchase the unit at Coulman Road, and to see a local company go from strength to strength.”

Paul Holmes, owner of the Real Yorkshire Pudding Co, said “Demand for our products remains high, and we view the purchase of the neighbouring unit as a valuable step forward for our growing business.”

Nick Prescott, industrial agent with [Gent Visick](#), said he was delighted with the outcome of the deal after previous negotiations between the parties had stalled.
