

Move on the menu for film caterers

A FILM location catering firm, which has provided meals for the likes of Russell Crowe and Daniel Craig, is relocating its national headquarters.

Chorley Bunce, which has worked on *Brideshead Revisited*, the BBC's *Merlin* series and the *Fifth Element* film, is moving operations from Harewood, on the outskirts of Leeds, to Pannal Business Park in Harrogate.

The company, which also has bases in London, Manchester and the Isle of Man, has just finished work on the new Robin Hood film, starring Russell Crowe.

The move is one of a string of new lets at Pannal Business Park which is located on the site of the former Dunlopillo factory, which went into administration in 2008.
