A FORMER Toshiba factory is springing back to life thanks to a run of new lettings by Leeds-based industrial property agent [Gent Visick](#).

MG Metal Design and Booth Autosalvage are the latest tenants at the Castleford site which already houses Bedworld, Burberry and NYK Transport.

MG Metal Design, which specialises in street furniture, bollards and security products have taken a two year lease on a 10,000 sq ft unit at the White Rose Estate.
