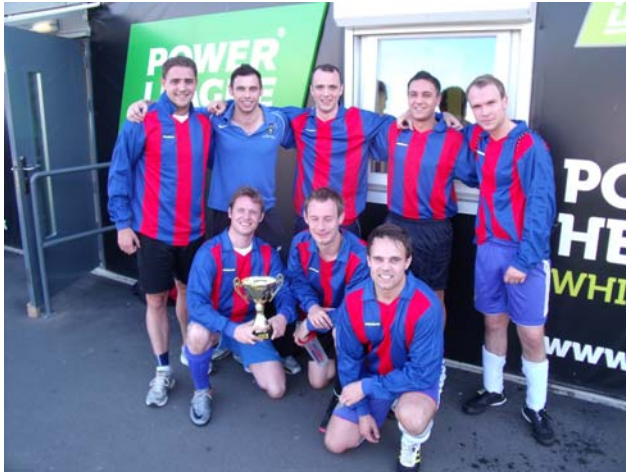


Shed-Shifters Team Wins Lucozade Business Power League
