Metals firm moves in next door to make room for growth

A METAL distribution firm is to double the size of its premises in Leeds after taking over the building next door.

ASD metal services, located at Valley Farm Road, Stourton, secured a new 15-year lease on the adjoining 215,000 sq ft premises, which will give the company a combined space of 400,000 sq ft.

The company, a division of Klöckner & Co multi-metal distribution, is multi-metals stockholder and distributor.

Chief executive Kaha Avaliani said: "The acquisition of the adjoining premises will enable us to centralise our stock-holding activities and increase efficiencies within our distribution chain.

"The new facility will

also allow us to carry a greater range of stock items and through the installation of new machinery offer a new service to our existing and future customer base."
